Brentwood, TN Nov. 17, 2008 – An exhibition of thirty-five photographs from twenty-eight local photographers will open on Saturday December 6th at Dunn Bros. Coffee's 401 Church Street location. Although the images range in theme and location, the image-makers have at least one thing in common; they are all members of the Brentwood Camera Club.
